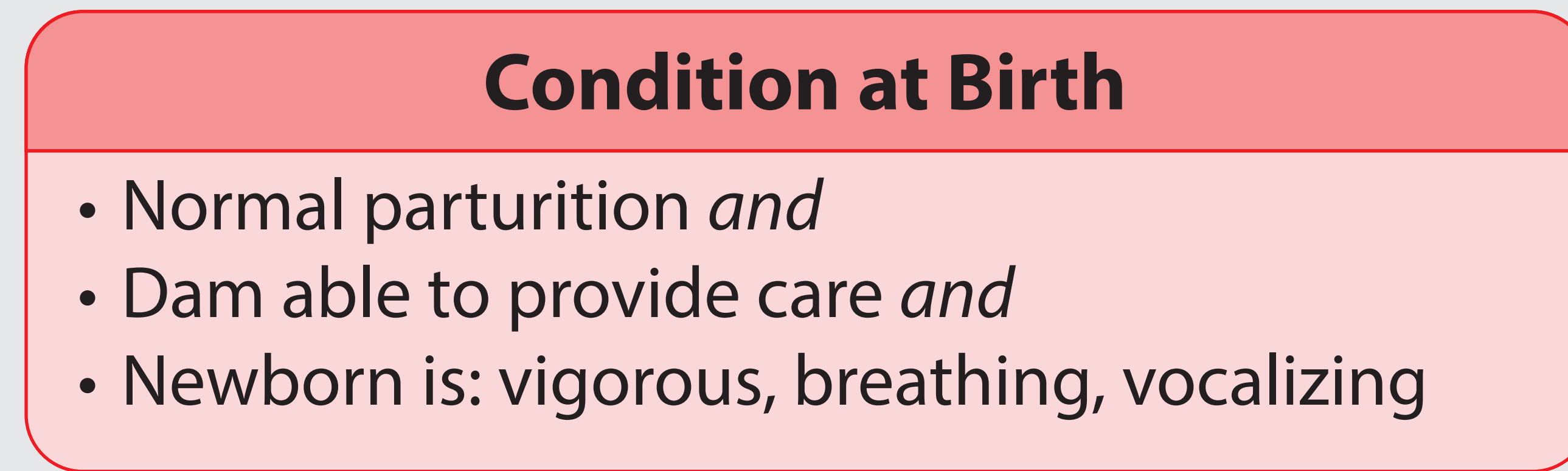

- Dry and stimulate
 - Clear airway/secretions
 - Initiate warming
- Goal: 95-99°F/35-37°C

- Newborn with dam
- Ensure warm environment

- Apgar at 5, 30, and 60 min
- Weigh every 12 hours

Normal

No heartbeat

Assess Heart Rate

>120

Assess Respiration

<120

Apneic or Gasping

Distress,
Cyanosis,
Low RR

- PPV with mask
- Heart rate monitoring
- Reversals if appropriate

- Ensure patent airway
- Oxygen supplementation
- Reversals if appropriate

Assess Heart Rate

>120

<120

- Verify effectiveness of PPV
- Consider intubation
- 100% oxygen

Assess Heart Rate

>50

<50

CPR

- Chest compressions
- PPV (C:V = 4:1)
- Vascular access
- Epinephrine

Adjunct Interventions

Suggest

- Glucose management
- Temperature management
- Doxapram
- IV/IO fluid bolus

Maybe

- GV 26 (< 3 sec)
