What is the RECOVER Initiative?

Launched in 2010 by veterinary emergency and critical care specialists, the RECOVER Initiative developed the first evidence-based guidelines for veterinary cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

Today, it remains the only official veterinary CPR certification endorsed by the American College of Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care (ACVECC) and the Veterinary Emergency and Critical Care Society (VECCS).

Developing evidence and consensus-based guidelines for veterinary CPR.

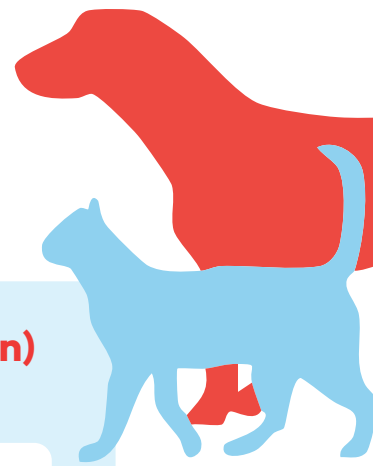
